

WatchDOGS – How It Works:

Watch D.O.G.S. (Dads Of Great Students) is an innovative father involvement - educational initiative of the National Center for Fathering. WatchDOGS are <u>fathers</u>, <u>step-fathers</u>, <u>grandfathers</u>, <u>uncles</u>, <u>and other father-figures</u> who volunteer for at least one day each year at an official WATCH D.O.G.S. school.

As a WatchDOG, you'll spend a portion of the day and lunch with your student and then the remainder of the day working with other VES students. You may help students with school work, supervise at lunch and recess, patrol the school entrances and hallways, assist with traffic flow and any other assigned activities.

Prior to your scheduled day, a reminder will be sent home with your student. On your scheduled day, please come to the school <u>office between 8:15-8:20am</u>. You'll receive instruction on the day's activities and your schedule. A WatchDOGS T-Shirt will be provided to you to wear or you may order your own WatchDOGS T-Shirt (https://store.dadsofgreatstudents.com/shop).

You are welcome to bring your lunch or you may purchase a school lunch. Please dress appropriately for outdoor recess and remember that <u>hats are not allowed to be worn during the school day.</u>

Signing up to be a WatchDOG is easy!

- 1. Simply view the WatchDOGS monthly calendars located on the Vermillion website at https://www.usd266.com/VES and select Programs/WatchDOGS/WatchDOGS Monthly Calendars to see what dates are available. To sign up simply email jdavis@usd266.com and include your name, phone number, student(s) and their teacher's name. (only ONE WatchDOGS per day please.)
- 2. You MUST complete a volunteer background check PRIOR to your first scheduled WatchDOG date. The background check can be completed online thru the VES website at https://www.usd266.com/VES under Families/Volunteer Background Check. (A volunteer background check will need to be completed each school year)
