Hello Families,

It's time to enroll for PAT Starlets Parent-Child Preschool Classes. We are excited about plans for next year and want to be sure to include you and your family. If you are not familiar with the Starlets Program, you may learn more about it on our website at <http://bit.ly/266Starlets>.

Starlets Pre-K classes meet once a week, and a parent (or other caring adult) and child attend together. Any Maize family with a child who is 3 or 4 by August 31 is welcome to enroll. We will be adding a Mini Starlets class starting January 2023 for those 3-year olds who turn 3 from September 1, 2022 – January 31, 2023 (if we have enough enrolled). We need a minimum of 6 families enrolled to hold the class.

Classes will fill quickly, so please print the enrollment form and return along with a nonrefundable \$30.00 enrollment fee to the MECC office. ENROLLMENT

Enrollment and health information forms must be completed for each child and on file with the Maize Parents as Teachers office. Please contact us with any e-mail, address or contact information changes.

PARENT INVOLVEMENT

All classes are designed for children accompanied by an adult to participate in a variety of activities. The child will benefit from the parent/guardian actively taking part with them.

ABSENCES

We like to encourage regular attendance in classes. As they are sign-up and limited in number, please try to attend each class.

ILLNESS

Participants should be free from any illness or fever to attend Starlets. Please do not return until fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication. If under a doctor's care, antibiotics should have been administered for a minimum of 24 hours.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

If Maize USD 266 is cancelling school, all PAT/STARLETS classes, special events and home visits will also be cancelled.

SIBLINGS

Each Starlets class is designed to target specific age groups. As we cannot provide childcare, siblings may attend; however, it is encouraged to bring only the child that is enrolled in the class in order for that child to best benefit from the parent's direct attention while participating in the appropriate age level of activities. Note: STARLETS may only bring siblings to classes designated for siblings.

BEHAVIOR

Each child is expected to use proper behavior and should be monitored by the parent or guardian who is accompanying the child. This includes siblings attending class. Please be courteous of other participants and, if necessary, step out of the room to comfort your child. We hope to provide a positive environment in which all children feel safe and successful during the activities.

SUPPLIES

Parents are asked to donate supplies for each class they are in. Ms. Erin will email out two supplies that you should bring.
