Event Tickets and Passes:

- Spectator attendance is limited to 25 percent maximum capacity.
- When available, tickets will be sold online through [TicketSpicket.com](https://www.ticketspicket.com) in advance to families of competition participants.
 - Participants include team members, band members, dance team members, and cheerleaders.
 - When online ticket sales are available, information will be communicated to parents.
 - When/if online tickets sales are unavailable, tickets will be distributed in an alternate manner to be communicated at the time.
 - When/if online tickets are available, no tickets will be distributed at the gate.
- Until online tickets are available a very limited number of tickets may be for sale at the gate. Once this limit is met, people will be turned away.
- Each participant will be allowed to reserve up to four tickets in advance.
- No Booster Pass, AVCTL League Pass, Senior Activity Pass, or Pep Club Pass will be accepted.
- Due to limited capacity, Maize USD 266 employees will be required to purchase tickets for events. Only those employees working events will be admitted for free.
- Gate workers will wear masks and gloves, and extra masks for attendees will be available, if needed.

General Guidelines & Procedures

- Family members and other spectators unable to attend home sporting events can watch live and on-demand at nfhsnetwork.com. NFHS Network subscription rates do apply (\$10.99 per month or \$69.99 per year).
- Fans will only be permitted to use the designated seating area for their schools.
- Temperature checks will be required for all indoor events.
- Spectators will be required to wear a mask and maintain at least six feet of social-distance while in common areas (ticket booths, concession stands, restrooms, etc.).
- Students in grades 8 and under will be required to sit with parents or family members. Students and children of any grade and age will not be permitted to roam freely at the venue during the contest.
- Students in grades 9 through 12 able to attend with a ticket will be seated in a designated area or will be required to sit with parents or family members. To enter an event, students will be required to purchase tickets in advance (if available).
- Only the home team will be allowed to have a dance team and band in attendance when approved by administrators. Spectators will be required to wear a mask at all times for indoor events.
- To reduce the risk of spread, spectators may not use elevated voices while in attendance.
- Spectators at outdoor events may remove masks while seated in the stands if social distancing guidelines can be met.
- Markings will define social distancing for those waiting in lines at ticket booths, concessions stands, restrooms, etc.
- Each school will have designated restrooms and concession stand for varsity football. Nonessential personnel will not be allowed on the field/track/ court before, during, and after an event.
- Spectators will need to exit the event at the conclusion of the game.
- All spectator guidelines are subject to change based on local conditions.
